### Significant Days and Celebrations



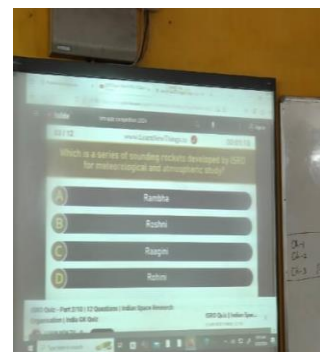

## Workshop on Parenteen and Student Counseling



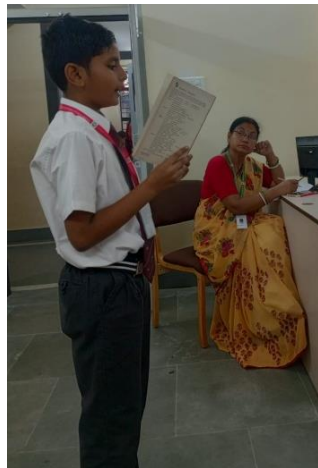

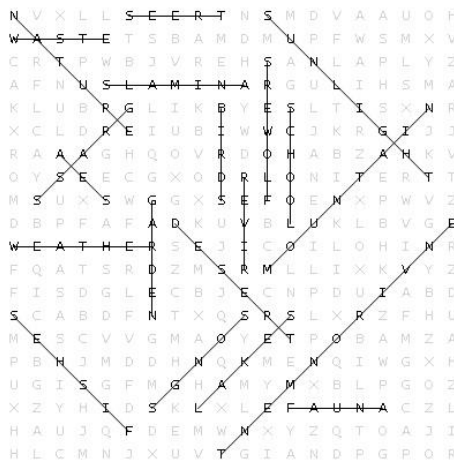
