Workshops and Seminars

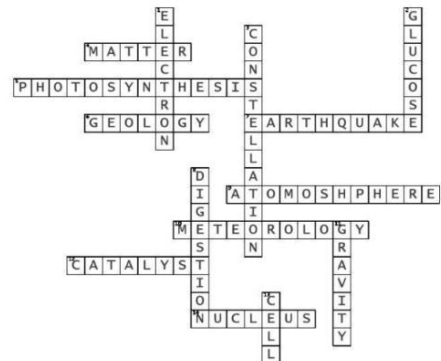
